ANNOUNCEMENT

Termination of requirement to submit Second Carrier Bill of Lading (BoL)

Bill of Lading (BoL) has been among the mandatory documents required by Maldives Customs Service for clearance of cargo arriving by sea. The BoL provides information about the exporter, weight of cargo, consignee, consignor, port of loading and particulars about the vessel. In instances where cargo transits through one or more international seaports, the Second Carrier BoL is also a requirement to provide particulars about last carrier vessel.

As the aforementioned information is now available to Maldives Customs Service through Cargo Manifest, concerned parties are no longer required to submit Second Carrier BoL, effective from 5 March 2020.
